Poland has just rolled out one of Europe's most ambitious energy storage programmes- a EUR980 million initiative that's set to transform the country's grid infrastructure. The Polish Ministry of Climate and Environment has finalised this landmark subsidy scheme, targeting over 5 GWh of new storage capacity by 2028.

Poland has finalized a comprehensive subsidy program aimed at accelerating the deployment of battery energy storage systems (BESS), with a total budget of PLN 4 billion (approximately EUR1 billion).

What is Poland's new energy storage scheme?

The scheme has been brewing since 2024, with the final regulation published in the Journal of Laws of the Republic of Poland in March this year. It received European Commission approval, which authorised state aid of EUR1.2 billion in state aid to support at least 5.4 GWh of new electricity storage facilities.
