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Do I have to pay taxes on a telecommunications service?

Depending on the types of communications you provide customers or that your products access, you might be liable to collect and remit taxes and fees including 911 and 988 fees, the Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) fee, telecommunications relay services (TRS) fees, utility user tax (UUT), and the communications services tax (CST).

How much tax credit can a solar PV system receive?

In 2021, and 10% for systems commencing construction in 2022 or thereafter. Any PV system placed in service after 2023, regardless of when it commenced construction, can receive a maximum tax credit of 10%.² Typically, a solar PV system that is eligible for the credit must use new and limited previous obligations.³

Is a solar rebate taxable income?

The amount of the ITC claimed; however, the rebate is not considered taxable income. For example, if the tax basis is \$1,000,000 for a PV system installed at an apartment complex and the utility gave a one-time rebate of \$100,000, and the project commenced construction before December 31, 2019 and was placed in service, the rebate is tax-exempt and subsidizes the cost of the system.

How much does UUT charge for telecommunication services?

Many California cities charge UUT on telecommunication services at rates ranging from ~2% up to 9% (Source: taxconnex.com). Missouri local governments impose business license taxes on telecom providers (often a percentage of revenue) in most cities (Source: taxconnex.com).

As indicated above for a solar PV property that commenced construction in 2021 and was eligible for a 22% ITC, when the tax basis is \$1,000,000, the 22% ITC reduces tax liability by \$220,000.

In general, the provisions are effective for property placed in service after 2024 in tax years ending on or after the date the final regulations were published in the Federal Register, which is January 15, 2025.

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
